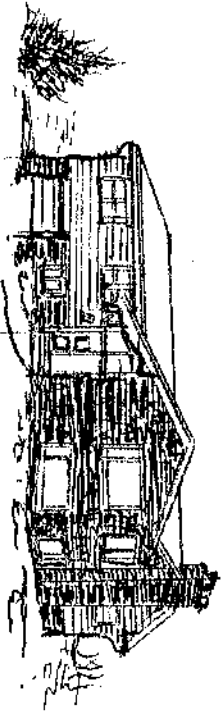

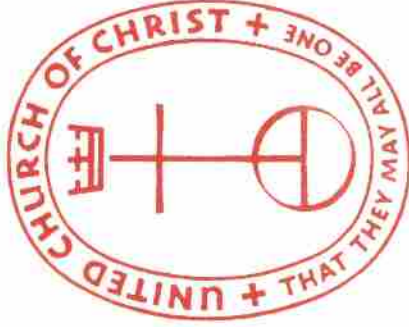

Daryl C. Higgins was born on October 20th, 1948. Daryl is a life-long resident of the Wadsworth, Ohio area and has been continuously active in many community activities and projects. Daryl attended Wadsworth Public Schools and was graduated from Wadsworth Senior High School in June of 1966, where he was active in speech, debate, music and student government. Daryl received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from Kent State University in 1970 where he was active in music, speech and student government. On May 19th, 1974, he received his Master of Divinity Degree from the Ashland College Theological Seminary in Ashland, Ohio.

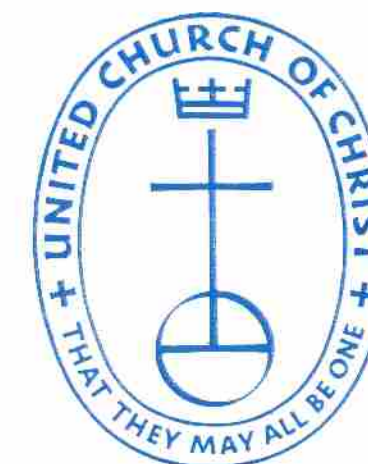
Daryl Higgins was raised within the fellowship of the First United Methodist Church of Wadsworth, and was confirmed as a part of its membership in 1959. From 1965-1970 Daryl worked actively with Rev. Glenn Lockard in many various leadership roles. While attending Kent State University Daryl worked as an announcer-newsman at WOIO-Radio in Canton, Ohio. From 1970-1972 Daryl served as the pastor of the Wooster Parish Circuit of the United Methodist Church. In 1971 he was ordained a Deacon in the Methodist Church by Bishop Francis Kearns at Lakeside, Ohio. In 1972 Daryl decided to seek full ministerial standing and ordination in the United Church of Christ. Later that year he was called to serve the Emanuel and Mt. Zwingli Parish of the United Church of Christ in Doylestown, Ohio where he is presently the pastor. On February 6th, 1974 Daryl received final approval of his ecclesiastical credentials by the Committee on Ministry of the Eastern Ohio Association of the United Church of Christ for his ordination on this date.

Daryl is currently active in the Wadsworth Kiwanis Club, the Wadsworth Jaycees, and the Doylestown and Wadsworth Ministerial Associations. In 1970 Daryl received the Jaycees Distinguished Service Award for community service.

I do and I will.

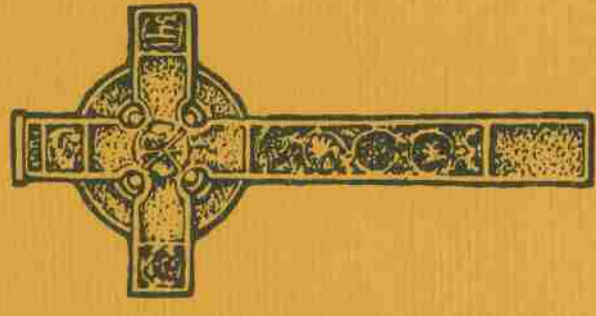

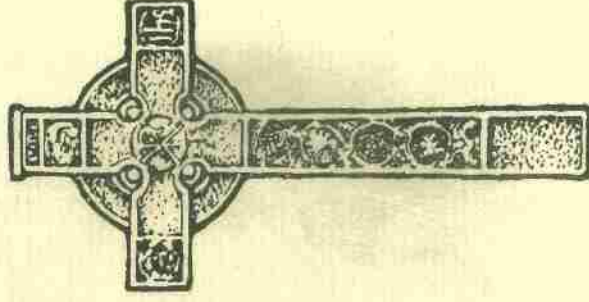

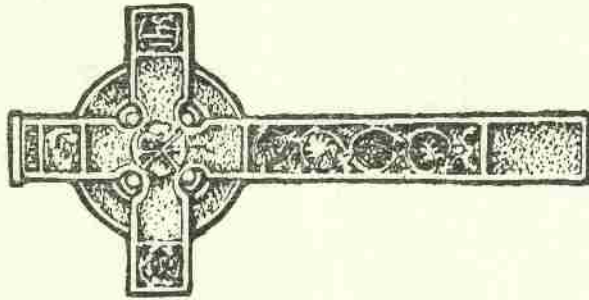
